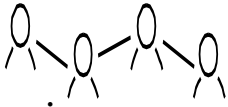


Let's pray

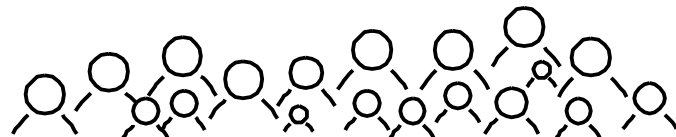
